Florence Nightingale is a famous British nurse who lived from **\AT** • to **\9.1** •. She helped to make hospitals cleaner, and wrote books about how to be a good nurse.

When she was **\Y** she had a religious vision telling her that her mission was to devote her life for people. She could finally convinced her parents to let her to become a nurse.

She began her nursing career during the Crimean War and tried hard to provide better hospital conditions for the wounded soldiers there. She is considered the founder of modern nursing. During the Crimean War, she was called 'The Lady with the Lamp' because she would work all night to make sure the soldiers had what they needed.

In ۱۸۶۵, she established a training school for nurses at St. Thomas Hospital in London.

She met Queen Victoria in **\\A\\Y**, when she gave Florence the Royal Red Cross to thank her for all of her hard work as a dedicated nurse.
