Chusok is one of the most important celebrations in the Korean calendar. Chusok happens in the eighth month of the lunar calendar (in either September or October), on the night of the full moon. During Chusok, Koreans give thanks and show their respect for nature and for people in the family who have died.

Nowadays, many people have moved away from their hometowns to work in big cities like Seoul. During Chusok, people who have moved away return to their hometowns to celebrate and socialize together. Therefore, the roads are very busy and the government gives everyone a day off work before and after Chusok. Many people use these days for traveling.

The first day is spent traveling or preparing traditional foods for ceremonies and eating. New rice is used to make moon-shaped rice cakes with a sweet filling. They are called Songphyun. Other foods are rice, soup, kimchi, fish, meat, fruits, and vegetables of the fall season.

The next day is the day of ceremonies and celebration. People dress in nice clothes. Some dress in Hanbok, the traditional clothing of Korea. There are traditional ceremonies in which foods are placed on a table as a commemoration for people in the family who have died. Everyone in the family enjoys eating and drinking together. Later, traditional games are often played. At night, it is a traditional pleasure to go outdoors under the full moon.

The third day is usually a travel day. People go back to their home, often far from their hometown. Chusok connects Korea with the past, but it is a celebration everyone enjoys in the present.
