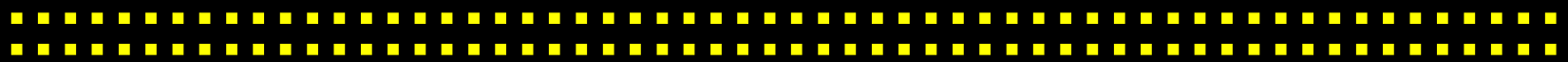

**The size of the smallest dictionary in the world is about 27×18 mm, which needs to be read with a magnifying glass.**



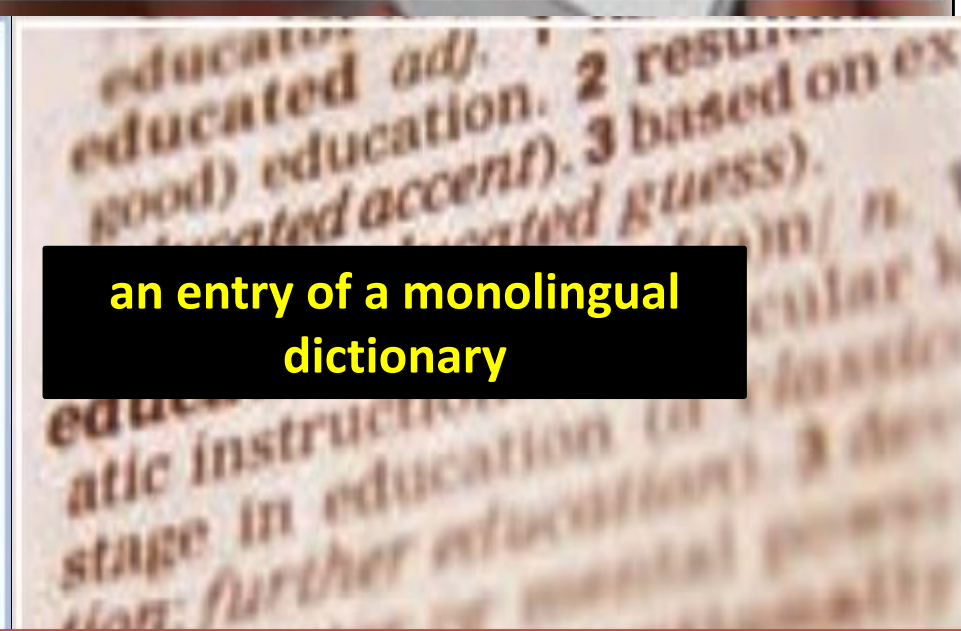

**1 to tell someone that a person or thing is good or useful**

Can you recommend a hotel near the airport?

**2 to tell someone in a helpful way what you think they should do**

I recommend that you see a doctor.

**SYNONYM : advise / Noun: recommendation**

**We followed their recommendation and stayed at the new hotel.**



## sup·pose / sə'pəʊz/ verb (sup·pos·es, sup·pos·ing, sup·posed)

**1** to think that something is probably true or will probably happen

- ◆ *"Where's Jenny?" "I don't know – I suppose she's still at work."*

**2** a word that you use when you agree with something but are not happy about it

- ◆ *"Can I borrow your pen?" "Yes, I suppose so – but don't lose it."*

## be supposed to

**1** If you **are supposed to** do something, you should do it

- ◆ *They were supposed to meet us here.*
- ◆ *You're not supposed to smoke in this room.*

**2** If something **is supposed to** be true, people say it is true
